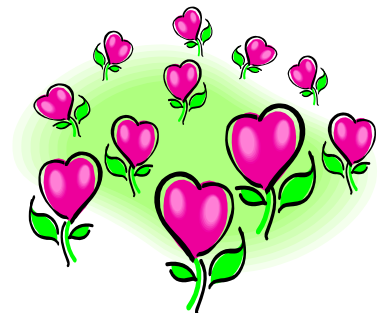

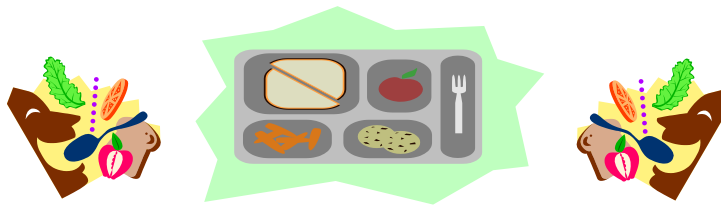
Hot Lunch News

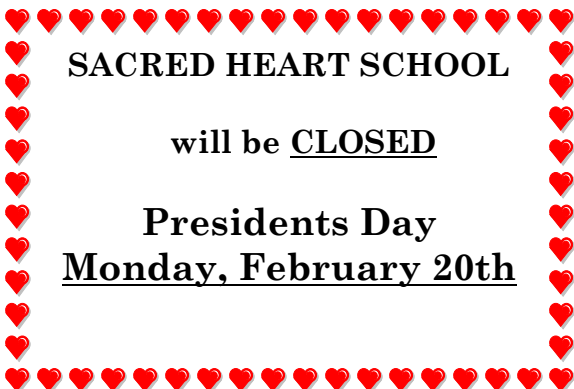
